This program seeks to facilitate the exchange of ideas and experiences between creators from Spain and the United States through artist residencies. These residencies address the general theme of heritage and conservation, focusing on the interrelationships between art and culture, the use (and re-uses) of the heritage sites, new opportunities and public participation in the actual context of the city and our society. The residencies will take place at the Cultural Center of Tabacalera in Malaga and the Presidio of San Francisco, a national park site in California. An artist from each country will do a month-long residency at one of the sites supported by a local curator.

Both cities and residencies will be connected through Portals, an ongoing global art project created by Shared Studios. Portals are repurposed shipping containers that serve as a concept, a program, and a physical structure. They use technology to help connect people across the world, as well as support interactive art experiences.
