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IT'S PLAYTIME!

An exhibition-workshop by Guda Koster

21 February 2025 – February 2026

It's Playtime! is an immersive installation by Dutch artist Guda Koster consisting of seven playful sculptures in a colorful setting. Legs of mannequins are combined with geometric and graphic forms, hiding the rest of the body, which makes the work humorous, sometimes disturbing, but always enigmatic.

The installation is designed as a playground for the young public. The sculptures offer multiple opportunities and children are invited to play and explore the installation. They can sneak and crawl through it, play with the visible and the invisible. The textiles offer a sensory experience. Games can be played with light and shadows, hide and seek and transformation by wearing a costume.

Each of these sculptures has a name: *Upside Down*, *Sticky Man*, *Noodle Man*, *Dress Man*, *Shadow Man*, *Sleeping Man* and *Out of the Box*.

Guda Koster

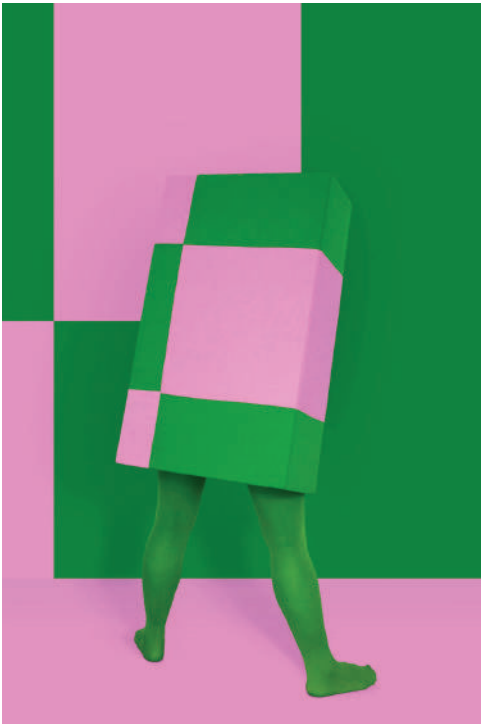
Guda Koster lives and works in Amsterdam. She introduces herself as a “visual artist”, creating installations, sculptures, performances and photographs.

Clothing is central to Koster’s work. To her, what we choose to cover ourselves with has the practical function of protecting the body, but it also conveys messages.

“In our daily life, our social position, function, or identity are visible in what we wear”, Guda observes.

“In this light, getting dressed can be seen as a form of visual art, a way to express how we see ourselves and want others to see us.”

Through her work, she suggests the possibility of a personal and private playground with light-hearted exuberance. And who wouldn’t want to stand out in the crowd and still be invisible?



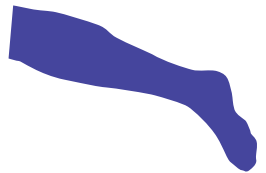
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It's Playtime!
